

About Conquer Cancer

Conquer Cancer[®], the ASCO Foundation, funds research for every cancer, every patient, everywhere. Through our strategic plan, Conquer Cancer donors support vital programs needed to deliver the highest quality, equitable patient care and share a vision of a world where cancer is prevented or cured, and every survivor is healthy.





- **General Support:** A Supporter will be listed as supporting at the General Support Level if they provide support that is below the Support Amount shown. Please note, at the General Support Level acknowledgments will be decided on a case by case basis.
- Underrepresented in Medicine (URM): Those who self-identify as from an underrepresented in medicine (UIM) population which includes individuals from racial and ethnic groups including Blacks or African Americans, Hispanics or Latinos, American Indians or Alaska Natives, Native Hawaiians and other Pacific Islanders; individuals with disabilities; and individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds. In addition, our definition of UIM recognizes that underrepresentation can vary from setting to setting; those with impacted life experiences, such as discrimination, socioeconomic status, historically underserved, or otherwise individuals from racial or ethnic groups that can be demonstrated to be underrepresented by the applicant's institution.
- Commitment Deadlines: The noted deadlines are the commitment dates in order to receive maximum recognition for support.
 Recognition may vary for confirmed support after the commitment deadline.
- Transparency Reporting: ASCO and Conquer Cancer will do our utmost to assist companies with their compliance obligations under the Physician Payment Sunshine Act and the SUPPORT Act when sponsored activities result in reportable transfers of value. Conquer Cancer kindly requests that companies review in advance the activities for which Conquer Cancer and ASCO are capable of providing reporting data, listed below. 
